### BOARD OF MANAGEMENT AGREED REPORT

The Board of Management (BOM) met for their fifth meeting of the school year on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2018.

The board were informed of the MLL Follow Through Inspection and the report was at Factual Verification stage. The recommendations of the provisional report were discussed by the board. The Board of Management were made aware of the general data protection regulations which comes into effect on the 25<sup>th</sup> of May. Work in this area is ongoing.

The Principal's Report included updates to recent developments that had taken place in Teaching and Learning. Six teachers participated in a co-teaching workshop as part of the school plan to embed Team Teaching in the delivery of the curriculum. They completed the workshop which was facilitated by the NBSS and the Principal was pleased to inform the board that the school has been selected as a pilot school for the modelling of co-teaching. The Principal also outlined the work that is underway in relation to the review of Post of Responsibilities in light of the new circular on Leadership and Management in Post Primary Schools.

The board were informed that Colaiste Abbain has had recent success at the local Enterprise Awards. Three Colaiste Abbain students won achievements at the Junior Enterprise Awards on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> March. The Junior category Winner represented Wexford at the National Awards in Croke Park on May 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Board congratulated 1<sup>st</sup> Year student Jack Barron for this outstanding achievement. Moreover, the school was awarded the Amber Flag for promoting positive mental health. The Board complemented the work being done in the area of Mental Health Promotion.
