CAO Deadline

Dear Parent / Guardian,

The closing date for CAO application is fast approaching

- Apply ONLINE before 17:15 on 20th January 2019 to avail of a discounted application fee of €30
- Students can apply before 17:15 on February 1st 2019 for a fee of €45.

Note: after February 1st 2019 your son/daughter may still apply but are considered a **LATE APPLICANT**. The fee for a late application is €60. Parents are asked to note that late applicants may also be restricted in course choices (see "Restricted Courses" below) and may be prevented from applying for access programmes such as DARE, HEAR and individual access programmes for Institutes of Technology.

Your son/daughter has been shown in class how to make an online CAO application. **Every student in Coláiste Abbáin is asked to apply to the CAO** <u>as well as</u> other non-CAO courses/training that they may be interested in.

Steps

- 1. Go to CAO.ie
- 2. Click "APPLY"
- 3. Select "Proceed with application"
- 4. Complete application form

There is a tutorial available on CAO.ie to explain how to complete the CAO application. Select "Student Resources" and "Demo application."

Note:

- 1. If you wish to apply for the SUSI grant, please TICK THIS BOX on the online application form before Feb 1st 2019.
- 2. If you wish to apply for HEAR or DARE schemes please indicate this on the online application form before Feb 1st 2019.
- 3. If you wish to apply for a language exemption, please indicate this on the online application form before Feb 1st 2019.
- 4. Many courses that require an interview or portfolio are considered as RESTRICTED COURSES and must be placed on the CAO application form before Feb 1st 2019. Your son/daughter was given a CAO Handbook earlier this year that indicates which courses are considered as RESTRICTED COURSES. Alternatively this handbook is available online.

Your son/daughter is being asked to complete the enclosed hard copy of the CAO application. They are asked to complete this **before Friday 11**th **January 2019** after which each student will have an individual meeting with the Principal and Deputy Principal in the school where their choices will be discussed and recorded on the school records. **Each student is asked to choose TEN Level 8 courses and TEN Level 7 courses.**
