Dear Parent / Guardian,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to inform you of a delay in the scheduled opening of our new Modular Building which was originally set for next Monday. Due to unforeseen circumstances and challenges that have arisen during the construction process, we find it necessary to adjust our opening date. The delay is primarily attributed to the Lift and SIM card/key issues. Despite our best efforts to mitigate these issues, they have impacted our project timeline significantly.

We have also implemented additional measures to expedite the remaining construction work and minimise any further delays. In doing so we should have the flexibility to use these free classrooms to relocate classes that were timetabled in the Modular Building.

Please be assured that we are doing everything in our power to expedite the completion of the project while maintaining the highest standards of safety. We sincerely apologise for any inconvenience this delay may cause, and we appreciate your understanding and patience during this time.
